TORRENTIAL RAIN DID NOT DETER HOMEOWNERS of The Verandas in Port Hope from attending a Welcome to the Neighbourhood Barbecue hosted by Geranium Homes on Saturday, June 22. A second phase offering new 48- and 42-ft. lots was released for sale during the weekend and many who came to view Phase 2 stayed for the barbecue. The Verandas is equally appealing to empty nesters and young families who appreciate the designs and affordability of these fully detached Energy Star qualified homes.

Three fully furnished and decorated Model Homes are open to tour which provide visitors with an opportunity to experience the great use of space in these modest sized homes and gain a feel for the quality of finishes included in every home. Set on 42- and 48-ft. lots, 10 different floorplans of two- and three-bedrooms are available with optional plans for more choice; including finished basement areas. Sizes range from 1,118 sq. ft. up to 2,397 sq. ft. (with optional finished lower level included). Phase 2 prices start from \$277,900 for a 42-ft. lot.

Located just minutes from Port Hope’s historic downtown, The Verandas will have a landscaped park, walking

paths and gazebo overlooking a pond upon completion. Situated within a private enclave setting, the 117 homes have attractive exteriors featuring covered front porches, double car garages and heritage influenced maintenance-free materials designed for beautiful streetscapes.

In addition to “Geranium Green” excellent construction standards, the homes at The Verandas are Energy Star for New Homes qualified, featuring third-party verification and up to 20 per cent energy savings (over homes built to Ontario Building Code minimum standards) from the day you move in.

Port Hope’s many amenities and conveniences are nearby, including municipal transit and VIA rail. The Verandas is just south of Hwy. 401, a 50-minute drive to Toronto and 30 minutes from Oshawa and Peterborough. The new Northumberland Hills Hospital is 10 minutes away. The Verandas neighbourhood is close to parkland, schools and shops.
