

WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE'S ANNUAL FOOD DRIVE SURPASSES EXPECTATIONS

The 3rd Annual Mayor's Thanksgiving Food Drive held October 1st to support the local food bank doubled food donations and exceeded \$12,000, due in large part to the contributions made by **Geranium Homes**.

Geranium held a 20-day advance campaign for residents and trades of **Cardinal Point** in Stouffville. This year's total donations surpassed all expectations reaching \$8,705. The funds were from Geranium's donation of \$50 per home sold in 2011 at Cardinal Point, contributions from suppliers and homeowners, and \$1,500 raised through Geranium Homes' children's book **Coby Builds A House**. Plus, tons of food items were collected.
